About the center:

Center for Cellular Signal Patterns (CellPat) was inaugurated on 1. November 2017 with the participation of: Jørgen Kjems (director; iNANO-AU), Duncan Sutherland (iNANO-AU), Steffen Thiel (Biomedicine-AU), Fiona Watt (KCL, London) and Ralph Jungmann (Max Planck Institute, Munich) as core members.
