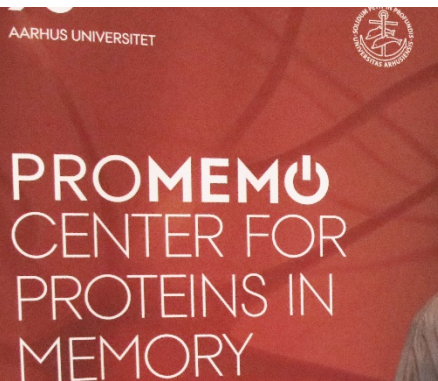

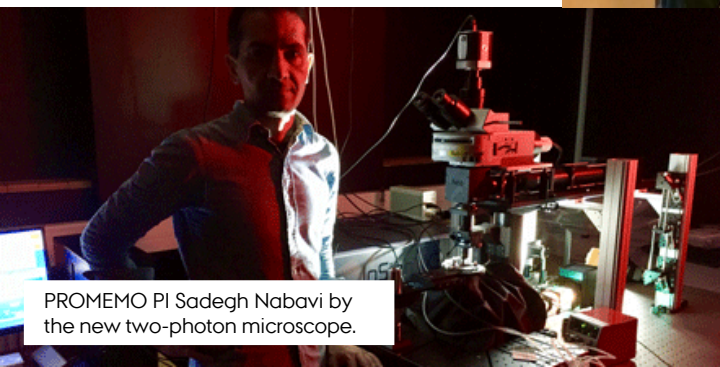
PROMEMO Workshop

Two-photon microscope installed

The installation of the new two-photon laser scanning fluorescence microscope was successfully completed in November. The microscope will enable visualization of communicating neurons and studies of the impact of specific proteins on this process.

The purchase was supported by the Danish National Research Foundation and Aarhus University.
